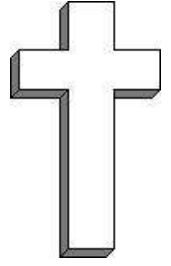


Broad Street Methodist Church welcomes you to Worship Sunday 14th October
